MINOR IN EMERGENCY HEALTH SERVICES

To earn a minor in EHS, in conjunction with a Bachelor of Arts or Science degree in another discipline, students must complete a minimum of 18 credits, including:

Required Courses: (9-12 credits)

- **EHS 115** *Medical Terminology (3 credits)*
- **EHS 200** *Concepts of Emergency Health Services (3 credits)*

Complete either EMT (6 credits) or EMR Certification (3 credits)

- **EHS 202*** *Emergency Medical Technician I (EMT I) (3 credits)*
- **EHS 203*** *Emergency Medical Technician II (EMT II) (3 credits)*
- OR -
- **EHS 102** *Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) (3 credits)*

*Students must complete both sections of the EMT for credit towards minor.
